### COVID-19

The February 2021 meeting was cancelled due to a COVID-19 lockdown as declared by the State Government.

There are obligations on the SVRRA, as a meeting holder, resultant from the COVID-19 restrictions imposed by the State Government. These include the requirement to maintain an attendance list. The Shire has sent a Contact Register hard copy and QR code for the Sawyers Valley Hall. The hardcopy details must be sent to the Shire after the meeting. Masks were required for this meeting and physical distancing observed.

### Annual Electors Meeting 2021

The Mundaring Shire Annual Electors meeting was on 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2021. No SVRRA members attended.

#### MLA Jessica Shaw contact

Jessica Shaw, Member of the Legislative Assembly for Swan Hills, had an information van at the Sawyers Valley oval for a week last year, but had no constituents visit.

The president extended an invitation to Jessica Shaw to our February 2021 meeting, but it was cancelled due to the COVID-19 lockdown. Issues of concern he flagged were:

- Rezoning of rural to urban land in the townsite
- Truck traffic through the townsite, speed and noise issues

The meeting resolved to invite Jessica to our next meeting in August 2021 to hear residents' issues. Residents will be alerted to this visit ahead of time and are asked to consider what issues of concern they wish to raise. Some additional issues mentioned included:

- Illegal rubbish dumped in the State Forrest, Beelu National Park and bush in other places
- 4WD and Trail Bikes travelling illegally through the National Park
- Increased rabbit infestation

Extending and invitation to an Echo newspaper reporter was suggested.

### Fuel Reduction Burn Feedback

The issue of damage caused by excessively hot fuel reduction burns was raised. When this was raised in 2019, feedback was given to the August 2019 meeting on this issue. It was decided at the meeting that after the Wooroloo fires it was worth getting more information on fuel reduction burns and hopefully lessons from the recent wildfire. A fire control officer will be invited to the next meeting.

The Wooroloo fires

- destroyed 86 homes
- burnt 11,000 hectares of bush
- had a fire front perimeter that reached 140 kms
- placed 69 suburbs on bushfire alert
- had embers blown 3.5 kms ahead of the fire front

The strong easterly winds blowing all week made the fire unstoppable.

### Rubbish Pickup by Ranger

The meeting was informed by a resident that while walking out from Sawyers Valley, rubbish was found dumped in the bush. This was reported to the Shire Rangers and was promptly removed. The resident was pleasantly surprised at the speed with which the Shire responded.
