# Parkerville Development on Kilburn Road

An article from the Echo, December 2021, was tabled at the meeting. It outlined details of the Kilburn Road development, which has been opposed by the Save Perth Hills group, the Stoneville and Parkerville Progress Assoc, the Mundaring Shire and more than 100 local residents. It will comprise 56 houses, be adjacent to the North Stoneville development and be located in a high fire risk area.

On 7<sup>th</sup> December, 2021, it was considered by the State Statutory Planning Committee. The committee did not reject it, nor defer it, as was requested, pending the completion of reviews, which include the Woorooloo Bushfire Inquiry, WA Bushfire Planning Policy and urban zoned land in the Perth Hills. It is feared this demonstrates the committee's intention to approve the development, despite local opposition.
