#### Possum Symbol used by the Sawyers Valley Primary School

Paul Benson spoke to Ian O'Neil who confirmed that the logo on the Sawyers Valley licence plates is the same logo as the primary school. Adriaan has compared the logo Florence created to the one used by the school. The school logo is very similar but has been changed in some details, those being, the possum is turned around and the initials and copyright symbols removed.

Adriaan feels that with the changed graphics, it can no longer be argued that it is the work of the original artist. He will approach Owen Briffa of the Lost Mundaring & Surrounds Local History Museum to see if they are interested in the Sawyers Valley Possum stickers created by Florence Charpentier.

**Grevillea Project**

Councillor John Daw advised the SVRRA of recent contact by Douglas Millar, Avon Recovery Centre Inc, with councillor Trish Cook, South Ward, regarding the Grevillea Park project.

In the correspondence Douglas has outlined the site as having an on-site doctor, psychologist, physiotherapist and councillors. Therapies such as equine and canine therapy, exercise and nutrition, music and art therapy, as well as horticulture therapy.

Adriaan attended a presentation by Douglas in February 2020, where he presented the concept. It includes 24 units on partially cleared land on the south side to the Gt Eastern Hwy opposite Lion St. The SVRRA has some concerns, which include access to the property from Gt Eastern Hwy or Millstream Drive. Adriaan has asked to be kept informed of any progress on the project.
